Christian Wolff is Director of the Luxembourg School of Finance and Professor of Finance at the University of Luxembourg, as well as a Research Fellow of the Centre for Economic Policy Research, London. He holds economics degrees from Erasmus University Rotterdam, and received his MBA and PhD degrees in International Finance from the Graduate School of Business at the University of Chicago. Professor Wolff was previously employed at London Business School and Maastricht University and held visiting appointments at the University of Chicago, the National University of Singapore, and INSEAD. He was President of the European Finance Association for the year 2005.

Professor Wolff has published in leading academic journals, such as the *Journal of Finance*, the *Journal of Business*, *Management Science*, the *Journal of Banking and Finance*, the *Journal of International Money and Finance*, and the *Journal of Business and Economic Statistics*, and is Founding Editor of the *Journal of Empirical Finance*. He has taught extensively in various MBA and executive programs. Professor Wolff has been consultant to many financial institutions and corporations. He serves and served as director and advisor to various investment funds and hedge funds and is Program Director of the Amsterdam Institute of Finance.
